A former school principal in the KwaZulu-Natal (KZN) Department of Education, Mr Pumza Nyawuza is Safer South Africa Foundation's KZN Provincial Coordinator.

Nyawuza holds a MA Degree in Education from the University of Zululand and a Bachelor of Education Honours from the same university. He also holds a Diploma in Education Management from the Rand Afrikaans University (now University of Johannesburg).

He has worked with various communities as a member of the Rotary Club of Hibiscus Coast. He has been a bigger part of Ntokozweni Old Age Home; engaging various civil based organisations to forge partnerships and get help in terms of getting necessary supplies for the Home.

Working with the community of Godloza at Ezingolweni, he is involved in helping vulnerable and orphaned children and empowering community members in accessing social grants and health services.

Nyawuza has been instrumental in mentoring a number of school principals in improving their management skills. He was a provincial representative in the Principals' International Conference, held in Cape Town, which sought to look at innovative ways to manage schools.

He attended the Common Wealth Conference for School Administrators and Managers. His work as an educator and principal lead him to Sweden, on a study visit to learn about other forms for better performance for school learners.
